Groups of these bridges or "elements" link together to form separate courses though the trees. Although every course has zip lines on them, there is much more fun than just zip lining to be had! There are five courses in total, for ages seven to adult, with challenge levels suitable for every age and skill level–from beginner to expert. Each person selects the course(s) they want and climbs at their own pace."
