Presidents Message

Hello everyone,

It's late September and it is still hot and humid. This will soon change and before we know it the snow will be flying.

You have seen reminders for club renewal so if you haven't done so, please renew.

With the approaching new season come changes on the mountain and in the village of Ludlow.

Okemo is introducing an additional bubble chair in Jackson Gore and also the RFID tickets. The basic difference in ticketing is that there will no longer be the need to exchange vouchers for tickets. They will be 'live' and scanned at the lift. With this change come functional precautions. The biggest one is that there can't be any other tickets on your person or they will all be scanned and thus invalidated. Another item is that there is going to be a \$1 per ticket return fee that Okemo is charging. This lends itself to being more prudent in our ordering practices.

In town the village has instituted new trash and recycling policies. As a result we will no longer have curbside trash pickup. Currently we are investigating options to take care of this.

The sprinkler system has been fully funded by loans from eight members. We thank them for their willingness to invest in the clubs future. The project is currently awaiting approval of the plans as submitted by our contractor. We anticipate it being completed be early fall. We have also been told that we will be able to use all the rooms in the lodge.
